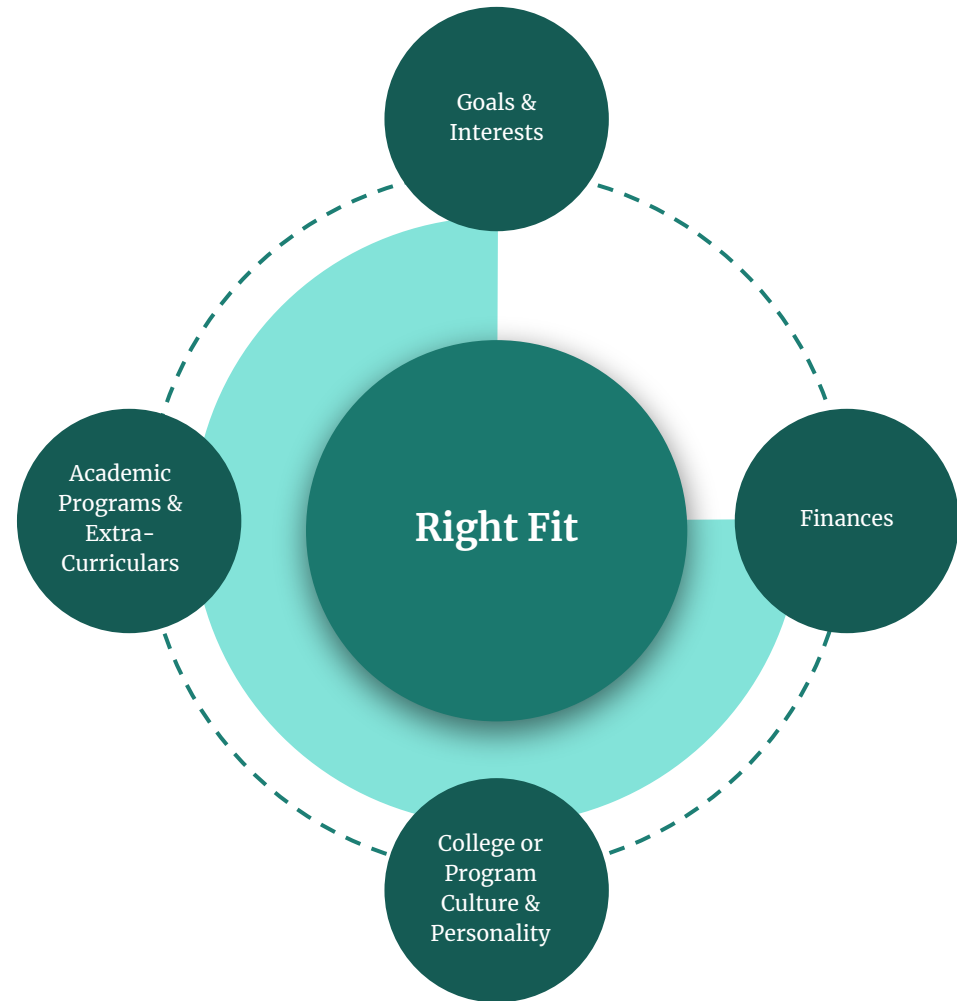

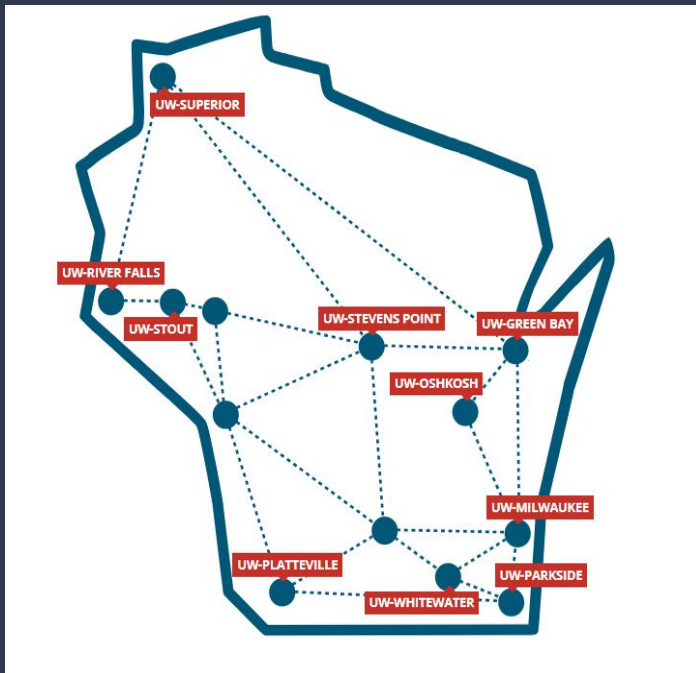

Direct Admit Wisconsin



Direct Admit Wisconsin is an initiative by the Universities of Wisconsin to proactively offer admission to qualifying high school students in between their junior and senior years of high school. Direct admission removes the traditional application process and instead uses data (high school transcript) provided by the high school to admit students to universities.

Students should expect to receive an email and a letter during the summer prior to senior year indicating which universities are providing direct admission and the next steps you need to take in order to learn more about enrolling.

*Participating in this program does not commit you to attend any of the universities in the direct admit program.

*Does not include: UW-Eau Claire, UW-La Crosse & UW-Madison

| 1-2 | Reach | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Highly selective admissions• Grades/scores could be around the average or below the average scores for admitted students• Acceptance could be possible but might be a long shot |
| 3-4 | Reasonable/Target | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Academic record and test scores are right in line with the averages• You feel like you measure up favorably and have a decent chance of getting accepted |
| 1-2 | Reliable/Safety | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Academic record and test scores are measurably above the average of admitted students |
